

## WCV Task of the 16<sup>th</sup> October 2005

9 adult volunteers, two helpful child volunteers and Rosie the spaniel spent two hours clearing rubbish from the disused Didcot, Newbury and Southampton railway line. The area cleared was about 200 metres at the back of Worthy Down Camp around grid reference 480 349 where a huge amount of rubbish had collected.

We filled dozens of bags with bottles, broken glass, rusty metal and other rubbish. Among the finds were hypodermic syringes and other items relating to drug use; old razor blades, a toothbrush and an umbrella!
